



SHOW APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The Brinton Museum's exhibitions committee meets in December of each year to review the work of artists interested in showing with this institution. Below are requirements to be considered for review.

- Artists who have not previously exhibited at The Brinton Museum should submit a minimum of 24 images (digital preferred), numbered and identified with artist's name, title of the work, date, medium and size, along with an artist's resume, education information and exhibition experience
- Please provide a self-addressed, stamped envelope for return of application materials, if you wish to have your materials returned
- Artists who have previously exhibited at The Brinton Museum and who wish to be considered for an invitational show, such as the institution's annual *Small Works Show*, should submit a minimum of 6 images (digital preferred), numbered and identified with artist's name, title of the work, date, medium and size

All materials need to be received by December 1

All applicants will be notified by February 1 of the committee's decision. Please be aware that shows are planned 2 – 3 years in advance.
