BIG HORN, Wyo (January 24, 2019) The Brinton Museum will again present the ***All Schools 5th Grade Student Art Show***, on exhibit in the 3rd floor Jacomien Mars Reception Gallery, February 8 through February 22nd. A reception for the students takes place on Friday, February 8, from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. This event is offered free and open to the public.

Participants in this year's show include nearly one hundred fifty 5th grade students from the greater Sheridan and Johnson counties as well as St. Labre Indian Catholic Academy and Wyola Public School in Montana. The Brinton's student art show presented annually in February is one of the highlights

of the museum's exhibits program and offers young artists the opportunity to showcase their artistic talents in a professional museum venue.

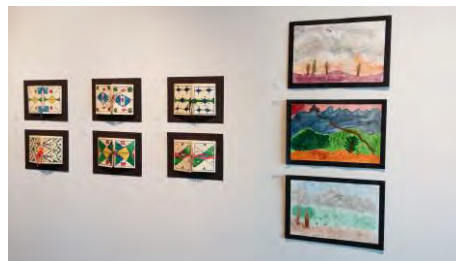
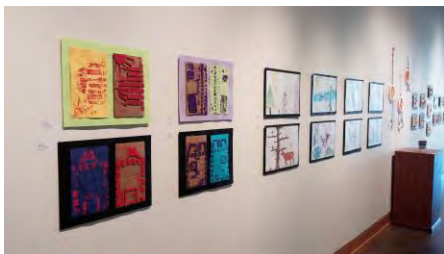
